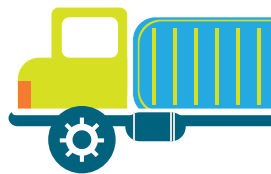

- **CPS Energy** – Light repairs
- **Code Enforcement** – Junk cars, graffiti, vacant lot clean-ups, etc
- **SAPD** – Target drug hotspots & additional community policing efforts
- **SAFD** – Install smoke detectors & fire/safety inspections
- **Animal Control** – Loose pets will be impounded & free micro-chipping for dogs and cats on May 20th.
- **Transportation & Capital Improvements** – Street maintenance
- **Solid Waste Management** – Dial-a-trailer & mitigating illegal dumping
- **Metro Health** – Mobile immunization clinic
- **Dept of Human Services** – Financial Counseling & emergency utility asst
